



Speaking / Oral Presentations Grading Criteria

1. Content and Purpose (20%)

2. Structure (15%)

- Content is **selected and structured**
- The texts is **unified** with **connected** elements
- Structure **reflects** the communicative situations

3. Language:

Accurate use of vocabulary and language structure (25%)

- **Awareness** of literal **meaning** and social aspects of meaning
- **Accurate** and appropriate **use of vocabulary**
- **Accurate** and appropriate **use of language structure**

4. Language:

Pronunciation and articulation (25%)

- **Clear articulation** that doesn't impede communication and facilitates understanding
- Clear and Correct **pronunciation** that facilitates understanding and communication

5. Voice (15%)

- Comfort and **confidence**
- Adequate **speed**
- Adequate **tone** of voice

6. Use of materials:

- Supporting materials (formats) – report/ tales
- Illustrating materials (formats)

Bonus Points:

- **Presence and nonverbal expression**
- **Voice – artistic expression (# news/ theatre)**
- **Creativity**
- **Good organization of presentation**
- **Personal style**
